PAY ATTENTION & DONATE: Kansas just invalidated every transgender person's drivers licenses and state IDs – passing Senate Bill 244 and sending letters demanding trans folks surrender their IDs or face penalties without any warning. This was enacted after Kansas Legislature overrode Kansas Governor Kelly's veto of this anti-trans bill. This is especially alarming in a state that requires IDs to vote, in a country that is actively attacking "undocumented" individuals.
